- Consider how much kit you will be moving around with you, always pack your bag well in advance of traveling. This enables you to cut down any unnecessary creature comforts. (don't worry they will still be here on your return).
- Water bottle.
 - Water purification (iodine, chlorine, neutralising tablets).
 - Water filter.
 - Pocket knife - Swiss army/Leatherman.
 - Torch with spare batteries.
 - Universal plug adaptor. (check voltage).
 - Travel clothes line.
 - Pack down cubes (vacuum pack).
 - TravelPack with detachable daysack.
 - Permethrin treated mosquito net.
 - sleeping bag and liner.
 - Insect repellent containing deet, natural alternatives available.
 - 3 good pairs of socks.
 - Blister treatment.
 - Underwear min x 3 (unless you're a commando).
 - Cap/sunhat.
